# Updates: CMNS Dean Search



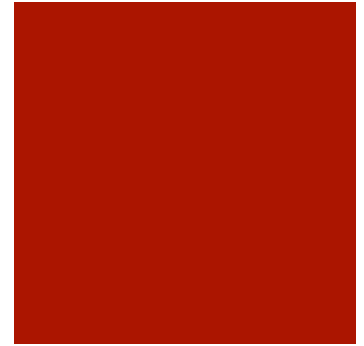
- Advertisement is being placed

# Updates: NSF Major Research Instrumentation Program



- Acquisition or Development of a Single Instrument
- Physical or **Virtual**
- Budget: \$100K to \$4 Million (150 awards estimated)
- Three Proposals per Campus
- Deadlines:
  - NSF: Jan 27, 2011
  - Campus: Dec 1, 2010
  - **Dean: Nov 19, 2010 (initial request)** [Campus Match Required: 30%]
- Recent Success:
  - Data-Scope: A Multi-Petabyte Generic Data Analysis Environment for Science (PI: Alex Szalay, JHU, Oct 1, 2010, \$2M)

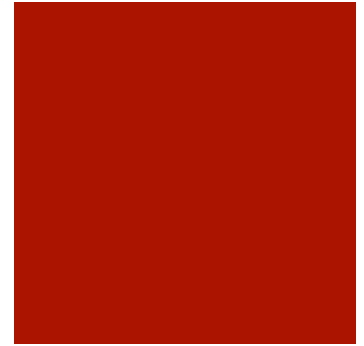
# UMIACS Seed Funding Grants FY 2011



- Goal: Initiate new collaborations and research directions that lead to significant proposals for external funding
- Team: 2 faculty from UMIACS, 1 from CMNS (but outside UMIACS)
- Budget: \$50K (4 awards estimated) with no overhead
- Timeline:
  - Submission: Dec 3, 2010
  - Evaluation: early Jan 2011
