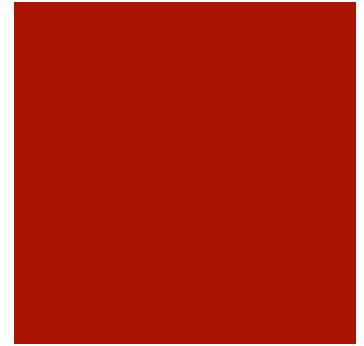

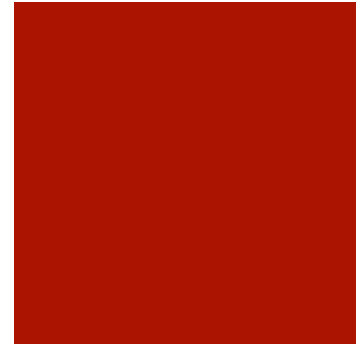

- Well over 600 requests serviced each month

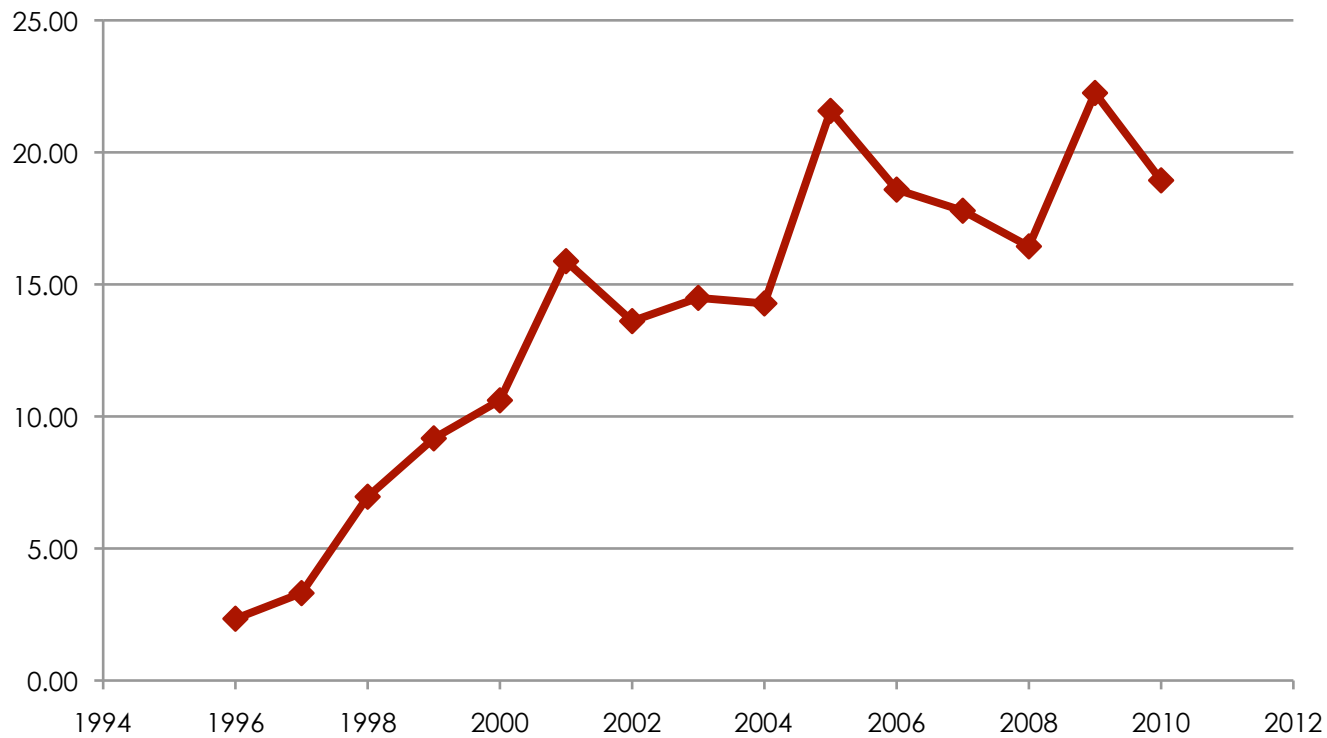

UMIACS Sponsored Research Funding



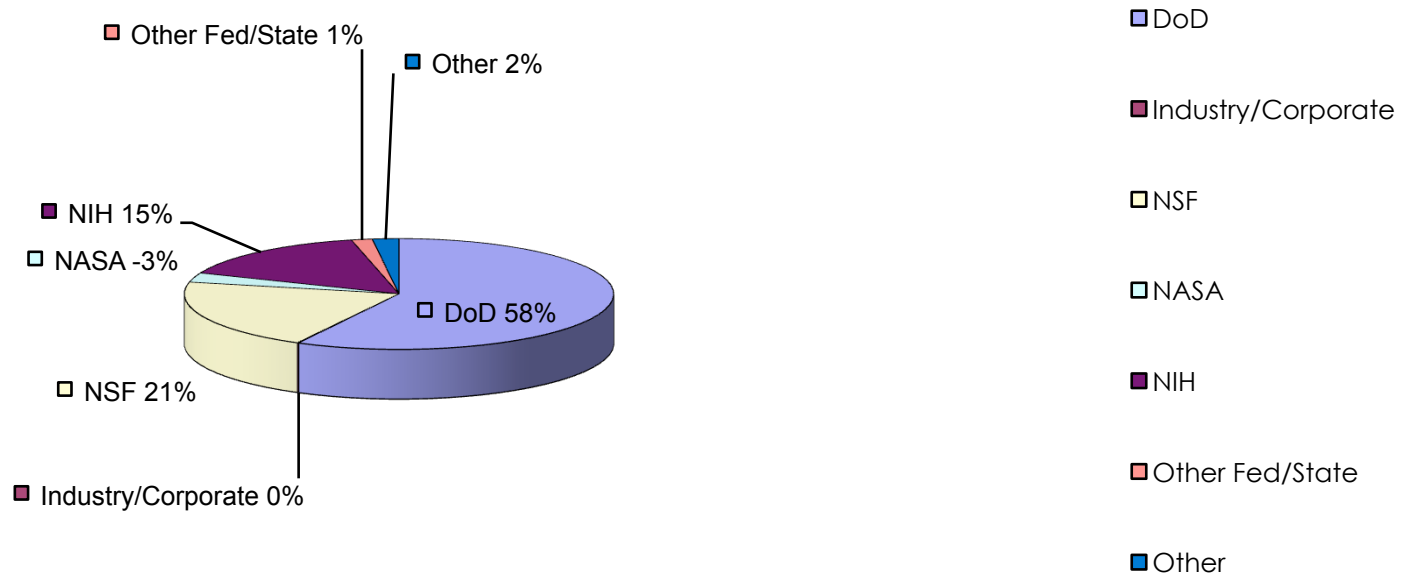
Research Funding (in millions \$)

2010 Sponsored Research Funds \$18,882,188

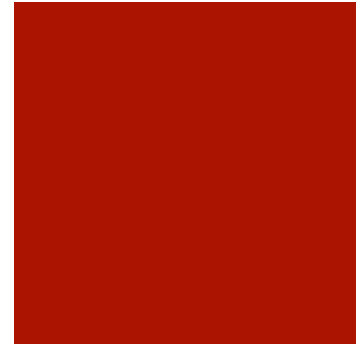

Features of new Web Site



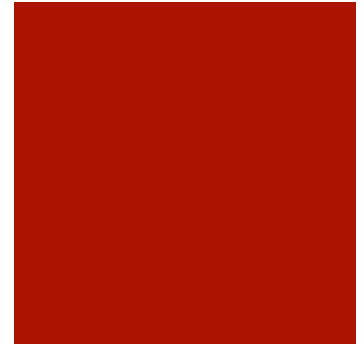

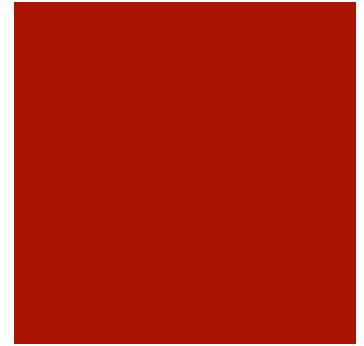

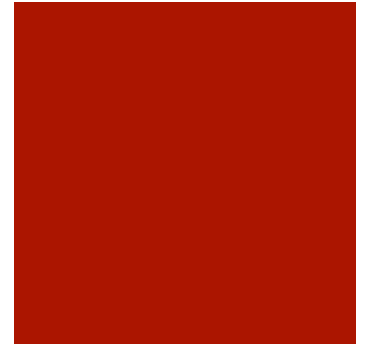
